ORDER

Pursuant to the July 9, 2020 Order (Dkt. No. 619), and the Notice of Further Proceedings sent to the class members (the "Notice"), a hearing on any objections to the February 27, 2020

Order concerning the court's intention to award \$60,000,000 in attorneys' fees to counsel for the class (Dkt. No. 590) shall be held on September 22, 2020, at 2:00 p.m., by videoconference. Instructions for how to register to participate in that hearing by videoconference are on the settlement website, www.statestreetindirectfxclasssettlement.com.

The deadline for class members to submit objections was September 8, 2020. The Notice directed class members to mail their objections to the court, the Special Master, and A.B. Data, the Claims Administrator. The court has not received any objections. However, the Special Master or Claims Administrator may have received objections.

In any event, it is hereby ORDERED that, by September 17, 2020:


1. The Special Master shall:

a) Consult the Claims Administrator, report whether any objections have been received and, if so, file them with the court;

b) File a memorandum identifying any issues to be addressed at the September 22, 2020 hearing and stating his views on them; and

c) File a proposed Order to be entered after the September 22, 2020 hearing.

2. Any law firm, other organization, or individual which wishes to have its views considered shall file a memorandum identifying and addressing any issues for possible discussion at the September 22, 2020 hearing.
